We rather liked Kogan's first generation of LED-backlit TVs and the second generation has likewise some features that are quite impressive. While the early models only offered USB playback, the new TVs give rudimentary PVR functionality once you plug in a USB hard drive or flash drive, and that's the big selling point Kogan seems to be pitching these 100Hz-capable models. That's a pity because the PVR functionality is very rudimentary and not that well implemented. We had trouble getting the TV to recognise some flash and external hard drives, and even when we could, we were hampered by the fact that

the PVR works in a single-tuner way, so you can't record something and watch something else at the same time. Other minor quirks that annoyed us were the garish remote control, which is overly busy and overly colourful, and the supplied stand, which is rather tricky to attach to the TV without a helper nearby. Those are minor issues, however, and aside from the PVR functionality, this is a decent yet not spectacular LED-backlit TV. At this kind of price, that makes it well worthwhile considering.
